

# WHICH MEASURES ARE VALID FROM 31<sup>st</sup> JANUARY



## RESPIRATORS PUBLIC TRANSPORT

INTERNAL PREMISES OF BUILDINGS e.g. shops, service provision outlets, healthcare and social facilities.

WORKPLACES – whenever one of your colleagues is closer than 1.5 m to you. SPECTATORS – at concerts, musical, theatre, film or other artistic performances, circuses and variety shows and sports matches

MASS EVENTS – indoors always and at outdoor events with over 30 people (without 1.5 m distancing)

EXCEPTION – children who have not yet commenced mandatory school attendance (except preparatory levels of PS) – children under 15 years of age – face mask



## RESTAURANTS AND BARS

Up to 6 people may be seated together at one table, more if they are persons from the same household.

A table with more seats allows for multiple groups of maximally 6 persons while keeping a distance of 1.5 m. O-N inspection upon entry.



## SKI LESSONS

For school ski lessons and ski courses arranged by an organiser providing services to persons aged 6 to 18: - pupils must present a negative PCR test result no more than 72 hours old - before commencing travel

– for courses lasting more than 7 days, the pupil must take another PCR test every 5 to 7 days

– the testing condition does not apply to children under 12 years of age and children with O-N.



## SPORTS MATCHES AND CULTURAL PERFORMANCES

If there are more than 20 people at the event, all of them must fulfil the O-N requirements. The organiser is obliged to control O-N.

The maximum capacity is 1000 persons, all seated.



## CHOIRS

Up to 50 choristers may participate.

Distancing of 1.5 m.

The organiser is obliged to inspect O-N, the chorister is obliged to present O-N.



## POOLS, LIDOS, WELLNESS CENTERS

Unlimited capacity; the visitor is obliged to present O-N; the organiser is obliged to inspect O-N.

Communal areas of lidos - 1.5 m distancing (except for the swimming area)



## LEISURE HOBBY ACTIVITIES FOR PERSONS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

Maximum outdoor capacity of 100 persons.

Obligation to control and present O-N if more than 20 persons participate.



## SERVICES

Distancing of at least 1.5 m.

The organizer is obliged to inspect O-N, the visitor is obliged to present O-N.



## PROHIBITION OF CONSUMING FOOD AT SHOPPING CENTERS

Meaning also in food courts (does not apply to separate restaurant premises).

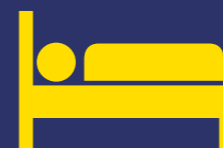


## MASS EVENTS (PUBLIC AND PRIVATE)

Distancing of at least 1.5 m.

Maximum outdoor capacity of 100 persons.

Presentation of O-N if more than 20 persons attend.



## SOCIAL SERVICE PROVIDERS

Mandatory testing of clients of selected social services who are not vaccinated or have not recovered from COVID-19 in the past 180 days.

An O-T-N exception applies for visits to social facilities.

O - after 14 days from completion of vaccination.

Y - for 24 hours from an antigen test or 72 hours from a PCR test with a negative result.

N - for a period of 180 days from the start of the illness.



## ZOOS, BOTANICAL GARDENS, MUSEUMS, GALLERIES, EXHIBITION SPACE, CASTLES, CHATEAUX, SIMILAR HISTORICAL OR CULTURAL MONUMENTS, OBSERVATORIES, PLANETARIUMS, TRADE FAIRS, SALES EXHIBITIONS

Capacity so as to allow a distancing of 1.5 m indoors.



## GROUP TOURS

Up to 20 persons within one tour group; inspection or presentation of O-N not required

Over 20 persons - presentation of O-N



## EDUCATION

Protection of the airways in communal areas; mask (surgical face mask) for children up to 15 years of age; respirator for children over 15 years of age.

No protection of the airways during teaching only if children are seated at their desks.

Unvaccinated teachers must wear a respirator for the entire time while teaching.

PREVENTIVE TESTING: PUPILS AND EMPLOYEES – Every Monday at primary and secondary schools and henceforth also at higher vocational schools.



### O-N

(completed vaccination, recovery from illness within a protective period of 180 days).

The O-N condition does not apply to children under 12 years of age.

Control of fulfilment of the O-N condition is performed exclusively via the Ministry of Health application “čTečka”.

A test may be presented by a person who has taken an RT-PCR test with a negative result no more than 72 hours ago, if this is:

- a person under 18 years of age,
- a person who cannot be vaccinated against COVID-19 due to counter-indications,

- a person partly vaccinated against COVID-19,
- a person in whose case 14 days have not yet passed since completing vaccination.
